2. PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION

Councillors called meeting to discuss the Premises Licence application – there are 4 Sections where Councillors and individuals can make representations

1. Prevention of Crime and Disorder
2. Public Safety
3. Prevention of Public Nuisance
4. Protection of Children from Harm

Councillors agreed after discussion to make two representations


2. Public Safety

Vehicular and pedestrian access from the promenade involves crossing the railway line by the public crossing situated at the north end of the promenade. Pedestrian access is also possible using post office lane and from the Hendre Mynach camp site which is next door to the property. If the property is given a full Licence this would increase use of the crossing and therefore raises concerns about the safety of the public using the crossing. Due to the lack of sighting to users of this crossing there is a permanent speed restriction in place for trains travelling in both directions. Nowhere in the original planning application was there a mention of opening a bar on the premises.

3. Prevention of Public Nuisance

Councillors believe that the Hendre Mynach Campsite doesn't allow music or alcohol on site after 11pm – the concern here is that as there is access to and from the campsite this may cause a nuisance to the residents of the camp site. The application includes music inside and out and this could also cause a nuisance to close neighbours and campers alike.
